

MENS GOLF CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR 2021

All events will be played in accordance with R & A, USGA Rules & Local Rules of golf which are on the back of the card and displayed on the notice board.

To enter Competitions a filled in score card and entry fee is to be handed to the Office Duty Person. If Office is unattended, names must be entered in the competition book & fee posted in the entry box. After play, cards are to be returned to the clubhouse.

SATURDAY: - Hit off before 9 am or between 11.00 am & 1.00 pm. Special events may have limited hit off times. Cost \$10.

WEDNESDAY: - Hit off before 9.00 am or between 11.30 am & 1 pm. Cost \$10.

HONOUR BOARD EVENTS: - Must be played in groups of 3 or 4.

HANDICAP DIVISIONS FOR 2021

Divisions to be determined on the day.

If less than 28 players, there will be only one division, if less than 5 players there will be no competition.

The winner in each division will receive a \$20 voucher.

Balls down the line will be given – 1 for every 5 players entered.

When winning scores are tied, countbacks will be on holes 10-18.

Cards for stroke rounds are to record stableford points for handicapping purposes, and putts taken.

VISITING GOLFERS: - May win a club event but are not eligible to win a monthly medal or special events.

CLUB GOLFERS: A player must be financial & have a minimum of 5 rounds recorded on Golf Link within the last 12 months to be eligible to win honour board events.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS: - Are played as a 72-hole event over 4 x 18 holes stroke rounds. It will be played over 4 consecutive Saturdays with the course at its rated length. If a round cannot be played due to adverse weather, it will be played on the following Saturday. Ties for gross events will be decided by sudden death on the same day with a referee in attendance.

Played Concurrently:

Junior Championship - L Carracher Trophy – 72 Holes

Veterans Championship - McLaine Family Trophy – 72 Holes

B A Burton Trophy - 72 Holes net aggregate over Club Championship

The Match Committee will settle any disputed rules or queries.

The Match Committee may cancel an event due to adverse weather or course conditions.

The Match Committee has the power to alter the syllabus and the conditions of play.

Handicap divisions may be changed at the discretion of the Match Committee during the year.
