The successful applicant will be responsible for:

The overall management of the Euroa's Golf Club's golf course with an emphasis on the greens, maintaining them in good condition in accordance with the accepted principles of good greens, such as cutting, rolling, scarifying, coring top dressing, spraying, watering and any other renovating work as and when necessary.

Prepares and maintains greens, tees and fairways for play.

Supervises and participates in the operation, repair and maintenance of pumps, irrigation equipment and drainage systems.

Instructs volunteer work teams in the safe and efficient operation of all equipment associated with turf management.

Supervises the majority of chemical and fertilizer applications and undertakes the appropriate training and instruction of volunteers in this field. Responsible for all Occupational Health and Safety management in outdoor areas.
