CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.** Entries to be made by phone or e-mail, and entrance fees paid to the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Players entering and not attending may be sent an account. Field limit will be 96 players.
- 2.** Entries are restricted to Amateurs who are members of clubs of the Dalhousie District Golf Association which are affiliated with Golf Australia, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3.** Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited, together with such rules as are in force on the course over which the competitions take place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by those members of the DDGA Executive present. If there is any doubt the committee shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the Rules Committee of Golf Victoria whose decision shall be final.
- 4.** The Committee has the power to temporarily alter a player's Australian Handicap in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System.
- 5.** Any protest must be lodged in writing with the District Captain before 6pm on the day the disputed matter has arisen.
- 6.** All ties in Handicap Events will be decided on countback, as approved by the AGU, and play-off as the Tournament Committee decides in scratch events.
- 7.** Players must be prepared to play when called upon by the Committee.
- 8.** Limit of one trophy to each player, except teams event, Junior Championship and nearest-to-pin.
- 9.** All entrants will be made Honorary Members of the Broadford Golf Club for the Tournament. Play on the course in the week prior to the Tournament will be on the conditions stipulated by the host club.
- 10.** The D.D.G.A. Committee may at its discretion shorten the Tournament if weather conditions are inclement.
- 11.** Handicap limit 36.
