

EUROA WOMEN'S GOLF CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR 2022

All events will be played in accordance with R & A, USGA rules & Local Rules of golf which are on the back of the card and displayed on the notice board.

To enter Competitions a filled in score card and entry fee is to be handed to the Office Duty Person. If Office is unattended, names must be entered in the competition book & fee posted in the entry box. After play, cards are to be returned to the clubhouse.

SATURDAY: - Hit off before 9 am OR assembly at 11.00 am for hit off between 11.30 am & 1.00 pm

Entry Fee \$10. Special events may have limited hit off times.

WEDNESDAY: - Assembly at 9.00 am for 9.30 am - Entry Fee \$10.

9 Hole players hit off by 10.30 am, Entry Fee \$5.

18 HOLES COMPETITIONS

HANDICAP DIVISIONS FOR 2022

Division One 0 – 24

Division Two 25 – 54

If less than 12 players, there will be only one division, if less than 5 players there will be no competition. The winner in each division will receive a \$25 voucher or 4 golf balls. Balls down the line will be given – 1 for every 5 players entered. When winning scores are tied, countbacks will be on holes 10-18. Cards for stroke rounds are to record stableford points for handicapping purposes, and putts taken.

9 HOLES COMPETITIONS

There will be no competition for less than 3 players. For 3-4 players, winner receives a ball.

For 5 – 7 players winner receives a \$10 voucher. For 8 or more players winners receives a \$10 voucher and runner-up receives a ball.

VISITING GOLFERS: - May win a club event but are not eligible to win a monthly medal or special events.

CLUB GOLFERS: Must be financial & have played 5 rounds in the last 12 months to be eligible to win special events.

ECCELECTIC, BIRDIES, CHIP-INS AND PUTTS: - For Wednesdays & Saturdays commencement will start in March, entry fee of \$10.00 must be paid before recording scores.

A Similar competition will be held over the summer season of golf, entry fee \$10.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS: - Are played as a 54-hole event over 3 x 18 holes stroke rounds. It will be played over 3 consecutive Saturdays with the course at its rated length. If a round cannot be played due to adverse weather, it will be played on the following Saturday. Ties for gross events will be decided by sudden death on the same day with a referee in attendance. Scratch and handicap prizes are awarded for Divisions 1, 2 & 3.

The Match Committee will settle any disputed rules or queries.

The Match Committee may cancel an event due to adverse weather or course conditions.

The Match Committee has the power to alter the syllabus and the conditions of play.

Handicap divisions may be changed at the discretion of the Match Committee during the year.

All Major events, Monthly Medal and Honor Board Events MUST be played in groups of 3 or 4 where possible.

Conditions of Play are displayed in the Club House.
