Remove fallen branches from RHS gums just before gully - Completed 16 Dec 21

Cleared drain both sides of culvert on track just past fuel bowsers of sand that had water backing up onto fairway at the dip. – Completed 21 Dec 21.

Remove fallen limb from Scented Gum on LHS at start of fairway - Completed 10 Jan 22.

Removed large fallen branches from Scented Gum on LHS at start of fairway. - Completed 25 Jan 21.

Hole 2

Removed dead Wattle from gully LHS of green.- Completed 3 Jan 22.

Remove fallen Dead Pine from RHR of men's Tee Box - Completed 6 Jan 22.

Remove large fallen limb from Scented Gum RHS at Men's Tee Box, completed by Dick Farmer. – Completed 11 Feb22.

Trim lower branches from all Melaleuca's on LHS at start of fairway, carried out by K Seeber and R Farmer. – Completed 8 Mar 22.

Cut Lower limbs and branches on all Pine Trees on RHS from corner to the track to ladies 3rd Tee. - Completed 27 Jul22.

Cut lower limbs and branches from all Pine Trees on RHS from main track in front of ladies Tee Box up to the track going to the 3rd fairway. **–Completed26 Jul 22**.

Cut lower limbs and branches from the old Pine Trees on LHS deep near the little dam. - Completed 27 Jul 22.

Trim lower branches on the Melaleuca's on LHS between corner and the big Gum tree. - Completed 25 Jul 22.

Trim all lower limbs and branches from the Pine Trees on RHS alongside the both Tee Boxes. - Completed 3 Aug 22.

Build up low areas around sprinkler heads at rear of green with some sand. - Completed 23 Dec 22.

Hole 3

Remove a number of limbs from the dead Pine @ LHS of green near track to Men's 4th Tee box – **Completed 18 Feb22.**

Pick up and remove cut branches from Pine trees near track from 3rd to Ladies 4th Tee box. – Completed 28 Feb 22

Trim lower branches from all Melaleuca's on RHS at start of fairway up to corner, carried out by K Seeber and R Farmer. – Completed 10 Mar 22.

Cut and remove qty 2 large overhanging limbs from the Red Gum tree on the RHS of the Men's Tee box. – Completed 8 Apr 22.

Remove lower limbs on trees on the LHS of fairway from corner to the green to allow tractor access to cut the drain with the channel spinner machine. – **Completed 17 Jun 22.**

Cut down the remainder of the dead Pine tree at the LHS of green near track to Men's 4th Tee Box. Need to pile up and burn out stump. - Completed 17 Jun 22.

Hole 4

Remove fallen branch from Iron Bark tree on LHS at bend - Completed 6 Jan 22.

Cut up fallen branches from Red Gum near men's Tee Box Sand bin. - Completed 18 Feb 22.

Placed buckets of sand onto low and wet area on RHS of fairway approx. 100m from greenand erected GUR signs – Completed 3 Mar 22.

Remove fallen branch stuck in tree LHS at Men's Tee Box. - Completed 11 Mar 22.

Trim lower limbs on Sugar Gum on RHS at start of fairway to allow tractor to access and cut drain. – **Completed**17Jun 22.

Cut fallen dead Pine Tree on RHS of fairway in second row of trees - Completed 17 Jun 22.

Trim all Pine trees RHS from corner to approx. 100 metre marker to assist and keep drain clear as well as allowing access to drain. – Completed 25 Jul 22.

Remove fallen branches from Scented Gum on RHS at the gully - Completed 7 Feb 22.

Remove all dead branches from the Flowing Gum on RHS just forward of gully - Completed 7 Feb 22.

Remove large fallen limb on spotted gum on LHS close to the green. - Completed 11 Feb 22.

Remove lower limbs from front row of Pine Trees at LHS near dam. - Completed 18 Feb 22.

Cut off Stump to ground level from Flowering Gum RHS just forward of gully - Completed 18 Feb 22.

Remove large fallen limb from Gum Tree on LHS near track across to 1st Fairway, Carried out by R Farmer. – Completed 15 Feb 22.

Trim lower branches and dead limbs from Scented Gum on the RHS just short of the bend - Completed 28 Mar 22.

Trim lower limbs and dead branches from Spotted Gum on RHS just short of the corner - Completed 3 Apr 22.

Trim lower limbs on all Pine trees in forest area on between RHS fairway and 7th green. - Completed 10Aug 22.

Cut up and remove fallen dead Pine Tree in forest area between RHS fairway and 7th Green – Completed12 Aug 22.

Remove fallen limb from LHS at approx. 150 marker that had fallen over the fence. - Completed 16 Dec 21.

Re assembled water fountain for dam, yet to be connected to pump. – Completed 24 Feb 22

Spike rolled bare areas around the greens of the 4th, 6th, 7th, 11th& 12th greens as a trial to get some water into these areas. – **Completed 23 Mar 22.**

Filled divots with sand and smoothed out on rear of all men's Tee Boxes. - Completed 21 Mar 22.

Spot sprayed fairways 1st, 2nd,9th,10th,11th,16th for Paspalum. – Completed 23 Mar 22.

Scarifying of all greens and blowing off of the extracted material was under taken by the contractor. Had an issue with the machine and caused some damage to the 18th Green. A number of other areas have turf ripped out due to poor root depth and areas of disease. - **Completed 28 Mar 22**.

Renovation by sanding, repairing damage, reseeding and fertilizing has commenced and will be on going for next two weeks or so. - Commenced 29 Mar 22.

Spike Rolled some of the bare areas on the approach to 18th fairway on RHS, LHS of 17th fairway rough, RHS and LHS of 16th Fairway and both sides of the 11th fairway to try and promote some grass growth. – **Completed 8 Apr 22.**

Connected water fountain to pump and all working now on a timer - Completed 12 Apr 22.

Filled low areas on 3rd, 6th and 7th Fairways where water lies. – Completed 28 Apr 22.

Took green samples and recycle water sample for free testing prior to Golf Aust working day at Shepparton on 24May 22. – Completed 6 May 22.

Ongoing patching, filling, topping up, seeding and watering in repaired patch areas on greens and surrounds. – Apr May 22.

Put Reno Gbp – Mini onto greens at rate of 8 kg per green. – Completed 16 May 22.

Applied more sand on to 2nd, 5th, 10th, and 14th wet spots in an attempt to dry these areas out. – Completed 17 May 22.

Verti cut all greens @ zero. - Completed 3 Jun 22.

Applied light sanding to all green wet areas and punched some holes in these wet areas. - Completed 16 Jun 22

Started cleaning and refurbishing the small drains throughout the course with the spinner drainer machine behind the tractor. – **Commenced on 17 Jun 22.**

Verti cut all Greens @ zero North South direction. - Completed 8 Jul 22.

Verti cut all Greens @ zero North South direction. – Completed8 Aug 22.

Repaired qty 2 flagsticks broken by Kangaroos – Completed 20 Aug 22.

Sub – contractor cored all greens and practice putting green and removed old cores onto piles near greens – Completed 1 Sep 22.

Sanded all greens and rubbed sand into core holes - Completed 2 Sep 22.

Sanded all greens and rubbed sand into core holes - Completed 6 Sep 22

Verti cut all Greens @ zero North South direction. – Completed20 Oct 22.

Repaired qty 1 Flagstick broken by kangaroos – Completed 21 Oct 22.

Verti cut all Greens @ zero North South direction. – Completed17 Nov 22.

Cut up fallen trees across the track towards the third green on the side of the large dam. - Completed 24 Nov 22.

Verti cut all Greens @ zeroNorth South direction. – Completed29 Nov 22.

Repair Broken Flag Stick - Completed 10 Dec 22.

Dusted all greens and Tee boxes with sand and washed in. - Completed 23 Dec 22.

Repaired broken Flagstick 4th Green. – Completed 30 Dec 22.

Watering System

The watering system used at the EGC is a Rainbird two wire system controlled by a Rainbird ESP – LXD Controller. (Refer U Tube for videos on trouble shooting system)

Repair major leak in old PVC system on 13th Fairway at T joint to 14th Tee Box sprinklers- Completed 29 Nov 21.

Repair Major leak (root damage) in old PVC system on track at 5th Ladies Tee Box on line to 3rd Men's Sprinkler Box. – Completed 29 Nov 21.

Aquatec replaced the main board and reprogrammed and adjusted the parameter's that controls the three pumps after numerous faults and no 2 pump, not running correctly after initial commissioning. – Completed 1 Dec 21.

Remove floating dam fountain and check for leaks, had sunken in weed, remove spray nozzle frame, turn upside down and refloat to check for leaks in floats. – **Completed 6 Dec 21**

Repair and overhauled complete sprinkler system, check main watering programme and test system for faults with assistance from LTZ Electrical for 2. 5 hrs labour. Initially there were 128 faults in system and after some reconnecting of wires, retest the system the faults were reduced to 66. Then starting replacing Solenoid coils approx. qty 12 and other faults. Replaced qty 4 Single coil decoders and Retested system reduced faults to 32 stations. Reconnected wiring track on second fairway and had to reposition box due to wiring too short, all 2 F boxes worked. Repaired broken solenoid valve top on 13F4. Traced and found major short causing alarm to trigger at controller box in wiring between junction box on 14th fairway to 10 & 17 fairway. Once disconnected at 14 box, retested and faults reduced to 13 faults. By process of disconnecting, isolating, testing solenoids and wiring found dual decoder faulty at 10F3 and 10F4, Reconnected 17F3, & 4 and 10F5&6 and had sprinklers working on 17F3 & 4. Now need to replace dual decoder on 10F5&6, as well as single decoders on 13F4, 5,& 6. Have ordered more single decoders and spare coil solenoids for both valves from Water Plus. Started spraying stuck up sprinkler heads with Silicon Spray over the week and it appears to be having some success.— Commenced 6 Dec 21- Completed 10 Dec 21.

Replaced broken sprinkler head that someone had driven over on the 3F4 bank RHS. - Completed 16 Dec 21.

Replaced Single decoders at **1F3, 3F2, 13F4, 13F6** boxes, connected, updated computer and test ran. – **Completed 16Dec 21.**

Replaced sprinkler at **10G2** RHS as old one was too low and not allowing correct coverage of green and surround. — **Completed 20 Dec 21.**

Replaced Single decoder on **18G2** as sprinklers not coming on, tested ok with new decoder. Handle on water cut off valve rusted out needs to be replaced at this location. – **Completed 31 Dec 21.**

Replaced back sprinkler on 11T1 Men's Tee Box, not rotating - Completed 3 Jan 22.

Sprinklers at **16F1** did not turn off as programmed, and stayed on most of night, turned water off at 16F1 box until system can be tested. – **Actioned 20 Jan 22**.

Fitted silicon filled gel wire connectors to 13F4 and 3F4 boxes. - Completed 20 Jan 22.

Tested complete system and came up with Open Circuit at station **018 – 6F6** and **053 – 15 F1**. Replaced solenoids at both stations as they were showing high resistance. Tried to start off phone after repairs still will not work. Will have to await parts to replace decoders. New decoders ordered in meantime will start water by hand. – **Completed 24 Jan 22.**

Replaced Single Decoder at **6F6** box, adjusted programme, synchronised programme, test ran all ok. – **Completed 3Feb 22.**

Replaced Single Decoder at **15F1** box, adjusted programme, synchronised programme, test ran all ok. – **Completed 3Feb 22.**

Replace broken sprinkler at 1F4 on LHS at gully. - Completed 3 Feb 22.

Arrived at course on 3 Feb 22, Programme Alarm light was on and programme had stated 9.36 pm half way through 1-9 fairways when alarm triggered. No greens got watered during night. Manually watered greens by phone throughout day and found **9G1** not working, replaced solenoid, Test ran All Ok – **Completed 3 Feb 22**.

Tested system, indicated short circuits at station **034** - **7F2**. Tested station and found solenoid high voltage, replaced solenoid still not working. As this is a 4-station decoder at **7F1** and there were two spare decoder wires, used one of those, adjusted and synchronised programme and tested **7F1** and **7F2** all ok. - **Completed 4 Feb 22.**

Replace leaking sprinkler on lady's 9thTee Box. – Completed 11 Feb 22.

Replace non rotating Sprinkler head on Ladies 15th Tee Box - Completed 15 Feb 22.

Replace non rotating Sprinkler head on 13G2 RHS - Completed 20 Feb.

Replace badly leaking sprinkler head on 3G2 RHS. - Completed 22 Feb 22.

Tested and adjusted all Tee Box Sprinkler heads. – Completed 22 Feb 22.

Replace non rotating sprinkler head on 1F4 RHS just forward of the gully. - Completed 25 Feb 22.

Replace non rotating sprinkler head on 1F6 RHS just short of the mound near green - Completed 1 Mar 22.

Check all 1st fairway sprinkler heads nozzle holding screw for screwed in too far affecting the spray pattern and adjusted where necessary. – Completed 1 Mar 22.

Check all 9th fairway sprinkler heads nozzle holding screw for screwed in too far affecting the spray pattern and adjusted where necessary. – Completed 3 Mar 22.

Repaired Sprinkler valve at BBQ control box, tested comes on now and goes off. - Completed 15 Mar 22.

Adjusted **BBQ** sprinkler heads and checked rotation. Sprinkler head near**9th** mound not rotating all of the time and requires replacement. – **Completed 15 Mar 22.**

Replaced 2G2 LHF Hunter Sprinkler too low with Rainbird sprinkler. - Completed 15 Mar 22.

ReplacedNon rotating sprinkler head at start of 4F1, first sprinkler LHS. – Completed 15 Mar 22.

Tested and adjusted Spray patterns and rotation on Fairway and green sprinkler heads on 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th holes – Completed 15 & 23 Mar 22.

Swap engine from no 1 smooth roller to eliminate over revving engine. – **Completed 30 May 22**Remove fuel tank and check out throttle linkage, to see why over revving, Adjust linkage spring. – **Completed 30 May 22.**

Cut off rear legs on rear frame as they are too low and drag and damage the ground when you go through a low spot. – Completed 6 Dec 21.

Kioti Vehicle

RHR tyre flat, large stick punctured tyre. R & R wheel and take to Williams Garage for repair. – Completed 24 Mar 22.

Vehicle would not engage gears @ 10th green, tow vehicle back to shed and determine cause. Removedhose to clutch area and found CVT belt broken. Remove battery, exhaust pipe and clutch cover to gain access to belt. Foundbelt broken and ordered new original OEM belt from Sanderson's Machinery- Nagambie as no non genuineavailable Locally or Shepparton. Cost \$320.00. Drive to Nagambie and pick up belt. New belt to be fitted next week. – Completed 13 May 2.

Found forward clutch damaged and broken, unrepairable item, rang Sanderson's to order new one, told had to upgrade to latest design and this means replacing rear clutch as well, total approx. \$2700.00. Waited a week for parts to arrive and fitted and road tested vehicle all ok – **Completed 26 May 22.**

Vehicle has starting and idling issue, Inspect glow circle all ok, Clean air cleaner and clean fuel filter. Start and run all ok. – Completed 4 Jul 22.

Grating/ knocking noise coming from RHS front wheel area, jack up and remove RHS front Wheel and check out suspension components found movement in lower ball joint pivot. Remove split pin and tightened nut and refitted split pin. All ok. **NOTE:** slight wear in RHS Steering rack tie rod end. – **Completed 9 Sep 22**

Vehicle broke down near 17th green, no drive, suspected broken drive belt. Tow vehicle back to shed to investigate. Strip parts all parts to access clutch and drive, found bolt missing from that secures rear drive assy, found rear drive assy internal spline damaged beyond repair. Ordered parts from G V Ag and thanks to them at nocost and used old rear drive assy. Fit all parts and test drive, all ok. – **Completed 16 Dec 22**

Sand Spreader

Machine was seized when pulled out and tested for spreading. Clear spinner heads of accumulated sandstuck to spinners and free up conveyor belt. Adjust speed and test system. Test and Repair electrical wiring assactuating switch working intermittently. Swap wiring at solenoids but switch still occasionally not working. Switch requires replacing. - Completed 28, 29 Mar 22.

Drain Cleaner

Drive shaft fell off and broke the rear Universal Joint. Remove shaft disassemble and purchase new universal Joint from Bearing Services Shepparton. Replace universal Joint reassemble shaft and fit to machine. Replace seized loose pinch Bolt on spline joint (Cause of shaft coming off) to ensure shaft does not come off. Grease shaft and test run all ok. – Completed 4 Jul 22.

Purchase an extension Section for the Pole Pruner Chainsaw, Value approx. \$250.00, Order No 0628. – Completed 25 Mar 22.

Machinery Shed and Buildings

Advised McKernan Engineering to go ahead with the approval and erection of the 8 Cart, Cart sheds required by end of Sept 22. – Completed 4 Jul 22.

Order from Violet Town quarries a truck load of shire mix for the base of the new cart sheds. Spread gravel and level for base of cart sheds. - Completed 5 Jul 22.

All Holes dug for cart shed posts and frame work starting to go up. Had to hire auger machine to dig holes as hit sand stone at 200mm. Savs Hire direct invoice to golf club. Also dug holes for cart entrance gap at sheds and new gateposts at Mens 1st Tee box – **Completed 18 Jul 22.**

Cart shed frame work is completed and posts cemented in, door frames hung, cladding ordered awaiting delivery. — Completed 22 Jul 22.

Cemented posts in for carts to go through between machinery shed and end of cart shed so as members can loadand unload carts without opening course gate. Additional benefit will be to allow future access to course from newestate. – Completed 24 Jul 22.

Remove broken white eaten wooden post in rear machinery shed wall and Replace with Steel Post with weldedbrackets to suit existing mountings and bolt in place. – **Completed12 Aug 22.**

Carts sheds clad and ready for wiring. - Completed 8 Sep 22.

BD Electrical contacted and quote received for wiring of new cart shed. Quote passed onto secretary for discussion and approval from committee. Wiring includes fitment of metre to monitor actual cart shed electricity useage to control pricing members pay.

Quote includes new wiring from machinery shed circuit board to new cart shed because with additionalnew cart points added to original wiring it would potential circuit overload. — **Completed 10 Sep 22.**

Dig trench from machinery shed to new cart shed for power cable with clubs trenching machine and lay cable in trench and back fill. – Completed by Tony Walters and B & D Electrical Staff 19 Oct 22.
